2009 TILLY DEVINE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

COLOUR

Dark red almost black with crimson hues on the rim.

BOUQUET

Dark fruit and cedary oak on the nose with lifted menthol capsicum and floral notes.

PALATE

The palate is full and firm with concentrated blackcurrant, menthol and chocolate. Fresh leather and cedar characters on the mid palate lead to a long dry firm finish that is still coated with rich blackcurrant flavours.

CELLARING

Drinks well now but will show its pedigree and grace with careful cellaring for 10-15 years.
