COLOUR

Deep crimson with purple hues on the rim.

BOUQUET

Hints of cinnamon, clove and white pepper lift out of the glass while concentrated plum and blackberry fruit lay beneath.

PALATE

The flavours are full and round in the mouth. Layers of plum and berries while the savory spices fill the mid palate and carry through to a long finish of fine dusty and chalky tannins.

CELLARING

This wine drinks beautifully while showing off its' youthful exuberance. It will reward with careful cellaring for up to ten years.
